


Margaret de Clare, Gilbert & Joan's second daughter, was born in 1293.




Llewellyn ap Gryffudd attacked and burnt the castle in October 1270.




Gilbert & Alice's first daughter, Isabelle, was born in March, 9 years after they were married.




Gilbert de Clare married Alice de Lusignan in 1253, when Gilbert was 12 years old.



Gilbert de Clare married Joan of Acre in late April or early May 1290. Joan was the daughter of King Edward 1st, and was 26 years old.



Gilbert inherited his father's estates and the title of Earl of Gloucester when his father died in July 1262.




In October 1265, as a reward for supporting Prince Edward, Gilbert was given the castle and title of Abergavenny, and the honour and castle of Brecknock. Prince Edward later became King Edward I.




Elizabeth de Clare, Gilbert & Joan's third daughter, was born on September 16th 1295.
