To book your free visit, please follow these simple steps:

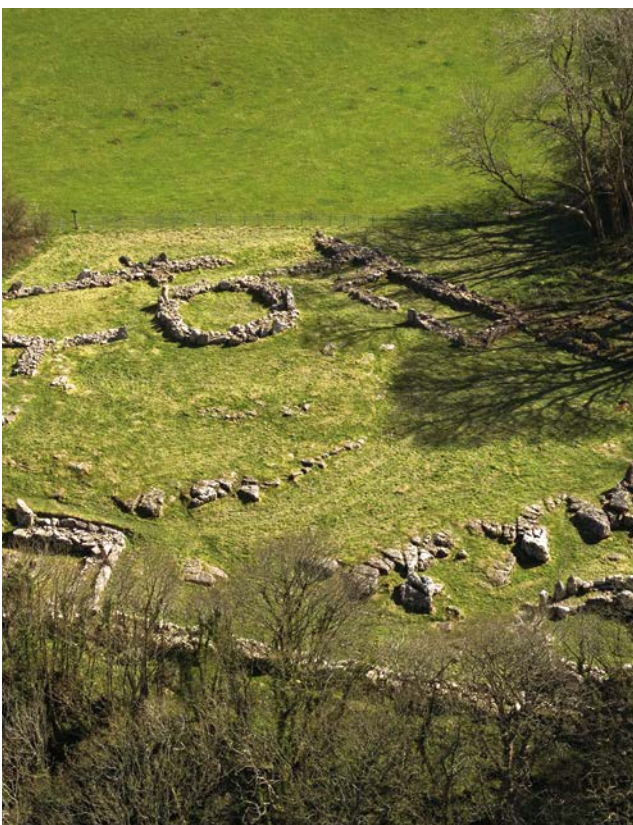
- Please book your visit at least five working days in advance.

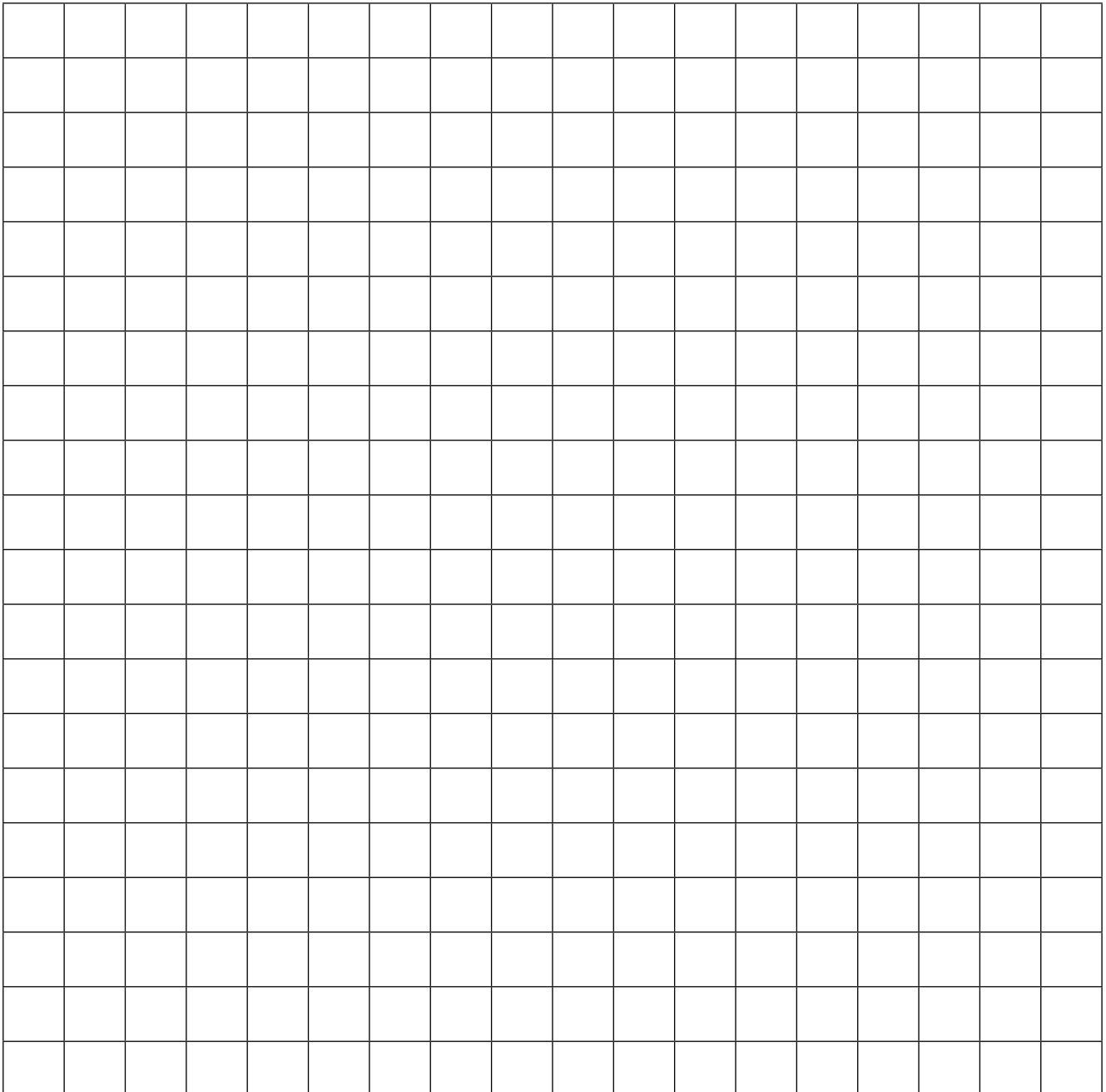
