

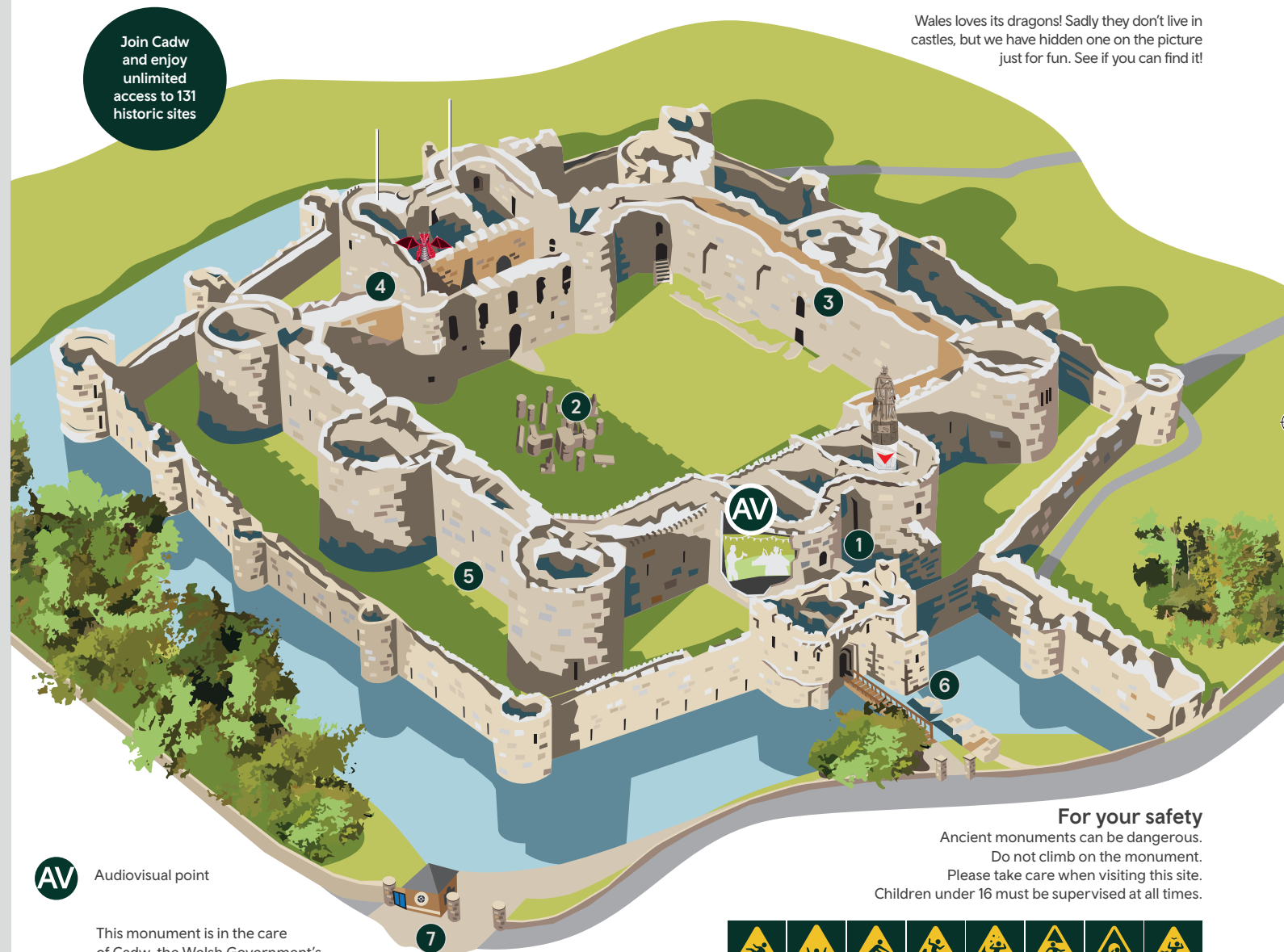
What to see at Beaumaris Castle

- 1 Watch out for deadly obstacles from murder holes above, arrows shot through arrowloops and the heavy portcullis when lowered.
- 2 Inspired by Beaumaris's amazing architecture? Construct your own castle, meet a master mason and more during your visit today.
- 3 Marvel at magnificent modern stained-glass windows in the chapel, set against elegant stonework. The king had a private chamber here to watch the service.
- 4 Climb up to the top wall-walk for stunning views of Snowdonia — the heartlands of the princes of Gwynedd.
- 5 Explore the wall-passages around the castle and discover ingeniously located latrines — built in pairs, with wooden seats and doors.
- 6 At high tide, ships could sail into the castle dock and unload supplies directly into the outer ward through a door in the wall.
- 7 Entrance/shop.
