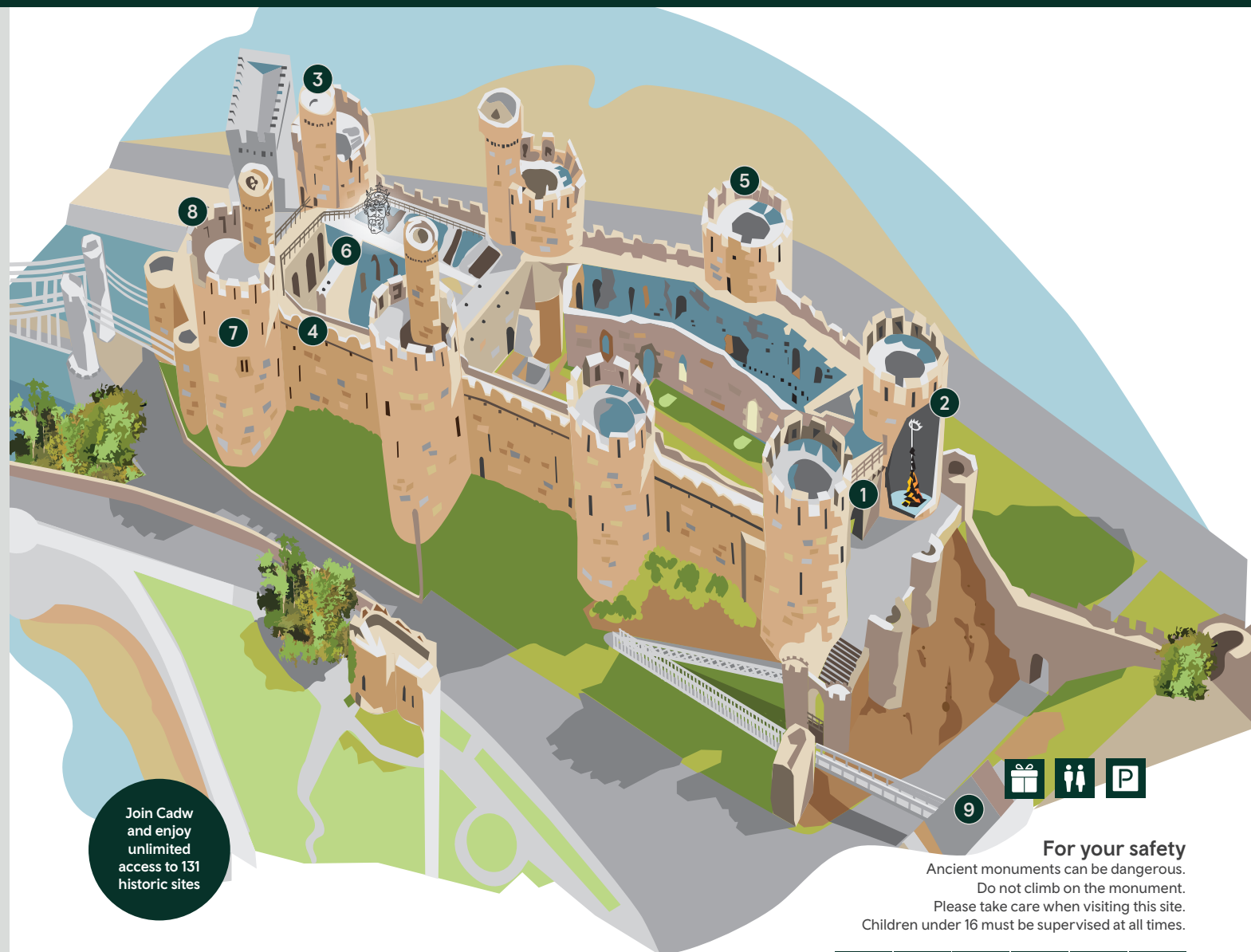


## What to see at Castell Conwy

- 1 Look out! The gateway here is protected from above by 'murder holes' — handy for dropping missiles on your attackers.
- 2 Seek out the sword atop 'Llywelyn's Coronet'. This artwork represents the spirit of the Welsh people.
- 3 Head for heights? Revel in the breath-taking views from the King's Tower.
- 4 Experience the thrill of a complete circuit of the castle's bold battlements accessed from the mighty towers.
- 5 Peer into the Prison Tower and pity the poor souls whose only light came from a single small window high above the floor. Can you find it?
- 6 Gaze at the best preserved medieval royal apartments in the country. So good, the king's still in residence (well, at least his head is).
- 7 Admire the detailed stained glass in Edward's ornate chapel, then search for where he watched the services in private.
- 8 Enjoy the East Barbican's views. These former castle gardens overlook the Conwy estuary and its three bridges including Thomas Telford's spectacular suspension bridge.
- 9 Entrance/shop.
