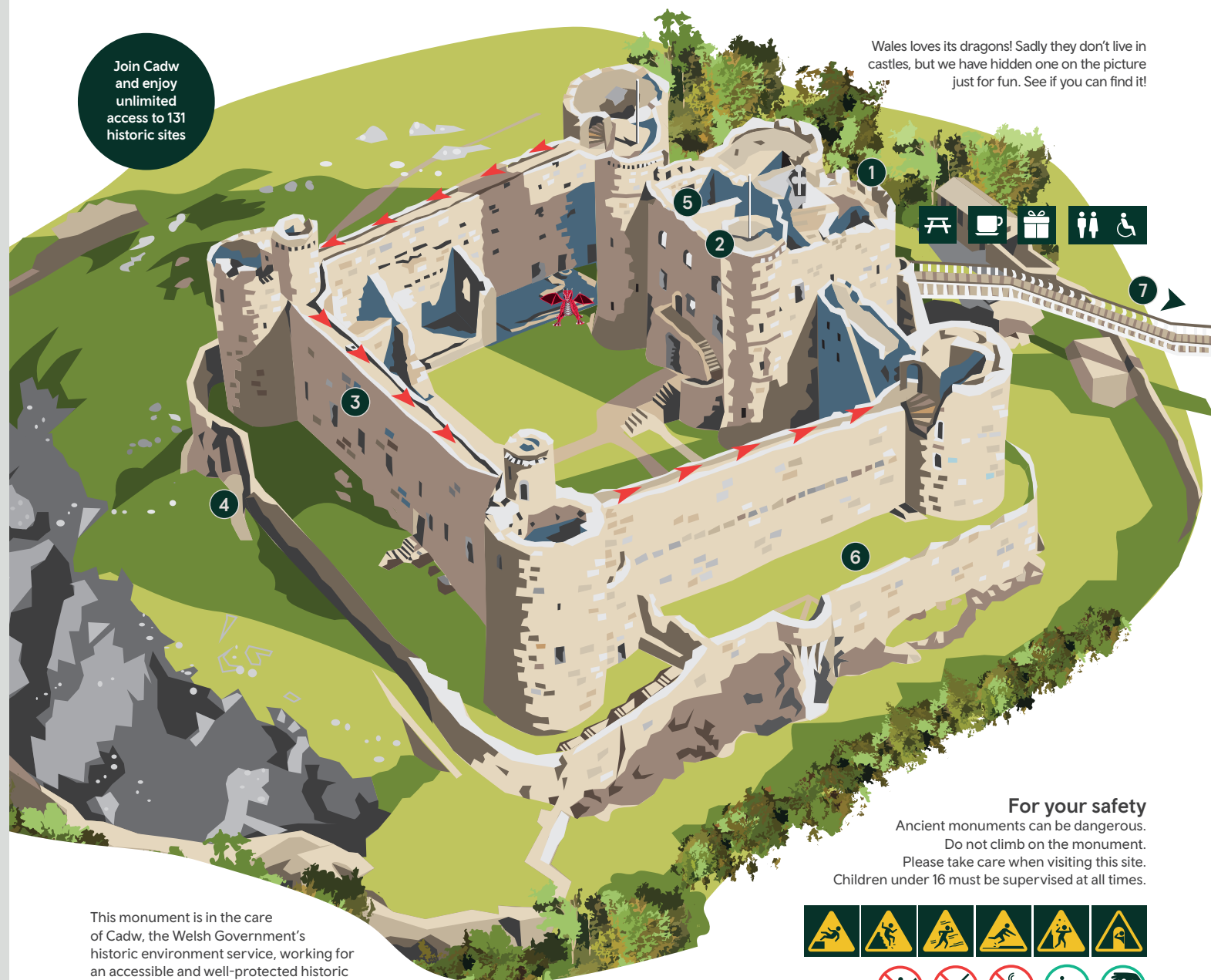


What to see at Castell Harlech

- 1 Heads up! Our gatehouse's protective portcullises and menacing murder holes made this a fearsome fortification.
- 2 Access the height of medieval luxury from the south-west turret. As you climb each floor, look into the gatehouse apartments — once the most sumptuous suites in the castle. The higher the rooms, the higher their status.
- 3 Touch the sky on our wonderful wall-walk. Follow the one way system to take in views of mountain summits and sandy shorelines.
- 4 Wander down the 'way from the sea'; a reminder that when Harlech was built, the coast was much closer.
- 5 Be 'bouldered' over by our medieval stone missiles, flung by Harlech's foes during one of the castle's many sieges.
- 6 Take a 'pee'k up the latrine chute by the south-west tower, or 'pee'r down the loo in the turret of the Outer Ward.
- 7 Entrance/shop.
