

What to see at Raglan Castle

- 1 See our exhibition inside our gatehouse on the history of this fortress-palace turned regal residence.
- 2 Get a taste for the best in Tudor catering as you explore the kitchens with their huge fireplaces, serving hatches and ovens.
- 3 Feast your eyes on the magnificent oriel window — designed to shed light on those seated at the Hall's high table.
- 4 Drink in the atmosphere of William Herbert's wine cellars. Custom-built over 500 years ago, they were stocked with fine wines from across Europe.
- 5 Meander around our Jacobean moat walk, its highly decorated brick niches once displayed statues of Roman emperors.
- 6 Climb the castle's oldest tower to take in some spectacular panoramic views. Pickaxe-wielding Parliamentarians partly destroyed this Great Tower so that it could never be used in battle again.
- 7 Step back in time to when guests would come out of their rooms in order of importance, proceed down the 'grand stair', through the Fountain Court and into the Hall.
- 8 Entrance/shop.
- 9 Toilets.
