Wedding Blessings/Commemorations

With effect from 1 April 2019 the following guidance must be followed in respect of all new blessing/commemoration bookings. Cadw's definition of a wedding blessing/commemoration is as follows:

- a short reading, poetry recitation or exchange of non religious vows at a monument, including photography.
- the blessing/commemoration can only consist of a maximum of 40 people, inclusive of the couple, the celebrant, and photographer. If the hirer requests additional guests standard admission prices will apply.
- the monument will be used for a maximum of 90 minutes, which allows adequate time for the ceremony and photographs and will only be considered during standard opening hours of the monument.
- the standard cost of a blessing will be payable one month in advance and is non refundable.
- all private hire functions must be directed to HQ for assessment before any initial indication of approval is given.
- if customers request any of (but not limited to) the following equipment, or would like an out-of-hours service, the application will be considered on the basis of a private hire and not a wedding blessing/commemoration:
 - PA System
 - Audio Equipment
 - Heating
 - Tables
 - Chairs
 - Lighting
 - Structures (Gazebo/Marquee of any type)
 - Catering
 - Decorations (of any sort)
 - Water Features/Fountains

Wedding Photography

With effect from 1 April 2019 the following guidance must be followed in respect of all new wedding photography bookings:

- the photography can only consist of a maximum of 15 people, inclusive of the couple and the photographer. If the hirer requests additional guests standard admission prices will apply.
- Welsh Government guidance on Covid restrictions must be adhered to at all times.
- the monument will be used for a maximum of 90 minutes, which allows adequate time for photography, all photography will only be considered during standard opening hours of the monument.
- the standard cost of the photography will be payable one month inadvance and is non refundable.
